Trebbiano from the Poggio Piglia estate, blended with some Vermentino made in collaboration with the biodynamic estate Incontri from Suvereto. Interpreted through stainless steel fermentation and maturation and unfiltered, for an "all fruit" experience made even more attractive by the use of grapes only (no added sulfites, yeasts, tannins, or anything else you can imagine).

Innovative thus so simple to understand, this wine is willing to explore new fields of taste, but in a modern cultural environment, where precision of scents, redox and volatile stability and the overall reliability of the wine over time are essential elements. The 2018 vintage showed out to be quiet "classical", having been relatively fresh and rainy both in spring than summer; its wines turned out to be pretty balanced and elegant.
