Therefore, **with Salco 2089 I just want to tell everyone what I mean by great wine:** a territory becoming a terroir through its history, years of hard work to make a vineyard mature while different vintages tell you unique stories, hours of tastings to understand how a wine could always be better, and some more time to discover an idealistic moment to drink it. **A never-ending story, just like time, and all this - only to be able to say, great!**

Perhaps it is not a coincidence that this Salco 2089 is a blend of two harvests of a mature vineyard, Salco, vintages so different such as 2008 and 2009 and that it was released for my 18th celebration.
